Back in the summer of 2007 this building was a rundown old Salvation Army Hall which in 12 weeks was refurbished and reborn into a multipurpose arts venue, with the help of the entire cast and chorus of Aladdin, who carried bricks, rubble and bits of timber whilst rehearsing and singing their songs. The building was transformed, with the final touches made at 3pm in afternoon and then opening at 7.00pm for 141 paying patrons was cutting it fine but we did it and now it is one of the best small theatres in the North East, and of

course a permanent home for the much loved Seaton Delaval Pantomime Society. The team here at the Arts Centre have worked so hard over what has been some tough years for all of us, but where we are today is beyond all our expectations.

Our patrons are so generous in supporting us by coming to see shows and attending the coffee mornings we organise, they are by their generosity helping us to grow with the community in which we are firmly rooted. It is also incredible to think that the entire operation is ran solely by volunteers who give up countless hours to bring 'Arts' to this area of South East Northumberland. Without them and the team of dedicated volunteers, the Arts Centre would not be at this milestone today.

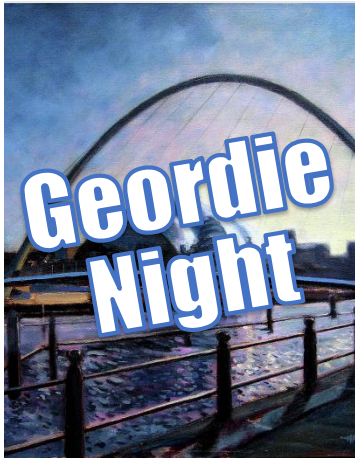
The Baldy Holly Band

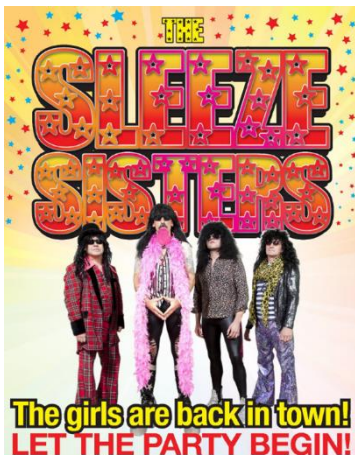


The Caffreys

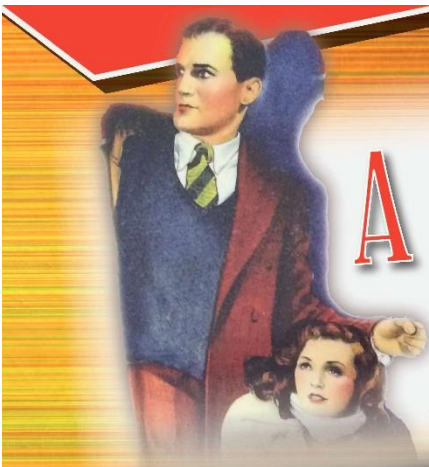
The Sleeve Sisters
